

Social Justice Internships

The FaithJustice Foundation has immediate openings for one or more part-time social justice interns to help organize Social Justice Summer 2020 and related programs. Internships are available for spring and summer.

The FaithJustice Foundation is a new nonprofit organization formed to equip and empower faith communities to take action for social justice. The goal of the FaithJustice Foundation is to provide education, training, and resources to congregations and other faith-based organizations who are or want to be engaged in grassroots, social justice ministry, advocacy, and action.

Social Justice Summer 2020 is a national call to action for congregations and other faith communities to a dedicated time of social justice-themed worship, study, discussion, and action. For 4-6 weeks during Summer 2020, faith communities across the country are invited to offer: a book study on social justice, a social justice sermon series, small group discussion, and at least one social justice action.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The Social Justice Intern will

- Help invite and recruit congregations to participate in Social Justice Summer
- Help recruit organizational and denominational partners to support and collaborate.
- Prepare fact sheets and other resources on issues such as economic justice, immigrant rights, education, voting rights, and criminal justice for congregations to use.
- o Help develop worship and small group resources for Social Justice Summer
- Coordinate and meet with team members as needed to carry out these responsibilities and to further the organization's vision and mission

QUALIFICATIONS

The ideal candidate will possess the following qualifications

- Bachelor's degree required
- Passionate about social justice and eager to help churches embrace their capacity to take action on social justice issues.

- Experience and/or interest in building relationships with individuals and partner organizations
- Excellent written and oral communication skills
- Ability to interact constructively with individuals with wide-ranging perspectives

POSITION INFORMATION

Position is a part-time internship, 8-12 hours per week, with a stipend.

ACCOUNTABILITY

Interns reports to Senior Advisor for Partnership Engagement.
